After a morning stop at the Jelly Belly plant, meet world renowned whimsical metal sculptor Phillip Glashoff at his Suisun Valley ranch. Stroll along walkways lined with countless unique sculptures. Glashoff works with steel to create images that will last.

After studying agriculture at Cal Poly State University, he realized his true passion was art and metal sculpturing. He took advantage of the rusty machinery, fire extinguishers, compressor covers, motorcycle tanks, and metal things that were abandoned and scattered around the farm to create his sculptures. His work is exhibited in galleries in Yountville, Los Olivos, Hawaii, Santa Fe and more, although he takes great pride in living and working on his Suisun Valley ranch.

After lunch, wander across the street to Suisun Valley Antiques where you might find anything under the sun. The business is associated with John’s Hauling which cleans out entire houses and seeks to sell or recycle the items it obtains instead of hauling them to the dump.
