

Spectacular San Francisco Sculptures

Featuring Douglas Tilden, known as the Michaelangelo of the West



Saturday, April 18, 2026

Begin our tour at the Ferry Building where we will meet our local guide, Craig Smith and see the "R-Evolution", a 47 foot-tall, 32,000 pound wire sculpture of a woman that will be on display until October. Then it is off to see some of Douglas Tilden's famous works including "The Mechanic's Monument", "Admission Day Monument", and "California Volunteers".

Douglas Tilden (May 1, 1860 – August 5, 1935) was an American sculptor. He was deaf from a bout of scarlet fever at the age of four and attended the California School for the Deaf in Berkeley, California, the Academy of Design in New York and from there, left to study art in Paris. When Tilden returned to San Francisco, he had a gift for capturing movement, strength and emotion in monumental form.
