Day 2. Friday, August 28th Montreal City Tour, Saint Joseph's Oratory, Notre Dame Basilica & Travel To Quebec City (B,D)

to 8:30 a.m. Buffet breakfast in the lobby of the hotel.

8:00 a.m. Bring your checked bag down to the lobby by 8:00 a.m.

8:30 a.m. Depart our hotel for our city tour. Montreal is a vibrant commercial and financial metropolis, with a large francophone culture and widely regarded as one of the most cosmopolitan cities in North America. Experience Old Montreal (Vieux-Montréal), which offers a window into the city's rich history with its cobblestone streets and architectural styles ranging from the 16th century to the present.

Visit Saint Joseph's Oratory, a magnificent basilica perched atop Mount Royal—Canada's largest church—featuring peaceful gardens, a grand dome, and sweeping views of the city. Then step inside the stunning Notre-Dame Basilica, a Gothic Revival treasure in the heart of Old Montréal, admired for its intricate woodwork, vivid stained glass, and brilliant blue ceiling.

Departure letter **Montreal, Quebec, Toronto, and Niagara Falls Tour** departing **Thursday, August 27, 2026.**

1. **Departure Location:** *Please arrive 15 minutes before departure time.*

Please Note: This Is A Very Early Morning Departure:

3:30 a.m. Lodi's Sunwest Plaza (2442 W Kettleman Lane @ Lower Sac.)

4:00 a.m. Stockton Inn (4219 E. Waterloo Road @ Highway 99)

4:30 a.m. Manteca pick-up and drop-off location is to be determined.

6:00 a.m. Join the tour at San Francisco International Airport - Domestic Terminal 2 – Air Canada Check-In Counter

Please Note: The Stockton Inn is the only place you can leave your car overnight.

2. **Departure Flight On Thursday, August 27, 2026:** Air Canada Flight #756 departing San Francisco International Airport at 8:10 a.m. We will be arriving into Montreal International Airport at 4:44 p.m.
3. **Return Flight On Thursday, September 3, 2026:** Air Canada Flight #745 departing Toronto Pearson International Airport at 6:30 p.m. We will arrive at San Francisco International Airport at 9:02 p.m. We will be back into Manteca, Stockton, and Lodi between 11:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m.
4. **Identification:** You must have your **United States Passport** with you to board the plane. I would also recommend that you bring a secondary form of identification.
5. **Baggage:** You may have one checked bag for this tour. The checked bag must weigh less than 50 lbs. You are also allowed a carry-on bag and a purse. Your carry-on bag should not be more than 8 x 14 x 22 inches in size. Backpacks work great as carry-ons.
6. **Luggage Tags & Luggage Straps:** Please find enclosed your luggage tags. We will be attaching Setness Tours straps to your luggage at the pickup locations on the first day of the tour. If you already have a Setness Tours luggage strap, please attach it to your luggage prior to arriving at the pickup locations.

7. **Airline Security:** Due to increased security measures, TSA has made changes to the prohibited items list.
- All liquids and gels greater than 3 oz. in size** – including shampoo, toothpaste, perfume, hair gel, suntan lotion, and all other items with similar consistency **ARE PROHIBITED** from carry-on baggage and the security checkpoint. Please pack these items in your checked baggage.
- Objects to put in your checked luggage (This is your large bag).** Sharp metal objects, scissors, razors, needles, tweezers, aerosol containers, cosmetics, liquids, gels, and anything that could be used as a weapon of some sort.
8. **Weather:** In Montreal, Quebec, Toronto and Niagara Falls during the month of September, the weather tends to be cloudy with a high temperature of 75 degrees and a low of 50 degrees. Bring a light-to-medium-weight jacket for the tour.
9. **Clothes & Shoes:** Please bring comfortable and casual clothes on the Montreal, Quebec, Toronto, and Niagara Falls tour. Daytime touring will involve a fair amount of walking, so please bring comfortable walking shoes.
10. **Tipping:** We will have some local guides for this tour. The recommended gratuity is \$10 dollars per person per day when we have a local guide. We will have 6 local guides during the tour, so please set aside \$60 dollars for gratuities for our guides. For our motorcoach driver, the recommended gratuity is \$10 per person per day, which is a total of \$70 for the entire tour.
11. **Tour Group:** Setness Tours has 20 local passengers on this tour. The group of passengers will be rotating seats regularly on the motorcoach. We will be on and off the motorcoach the entire day.
12. **Travel Recommendations:**
- Medications** - Pack a listing of your prescriptions and leave the prescriptions in the original container when traveling. Vitamins can be placed in the pill containers.
- Glasses** - When traveling, always carry an extra pair of glasses in case your glasses are damaged or lost. It will be nearly impossible to replace glasses during the tour.
- Alarm** – We suggest setting two alarms the night before the trip. This is a very early morning departure. Please bring a battery-operated travel alarm clock on tour.
- Cell Phone** – Please bring a cell phone on the tour if you have one. Make sure Shawn in the office has your cell phone number in our database. In case you get lost or need assistance, please keep the detailed itinerary with Wayne's cell phone number.
- Watches** – We suggest bringing a watch with you on the tour. Most people use their cell phone for a watch.
13. **Plane Travel:** Bring an Airplane Pillow, Ear Plugs, Sleep Mask (This covers your eyes.) You may want to bring a sleeping aid like Unisom or Sominex on the tour to help you sleep during the first night.

14. **Flight Time:** The flight time from San Francisco to Montreal is 5 hours and 34 minutes. The flight time from Toronto to San Francisco will be 5 hours and 32 minutes.
15. **Time Difference:** Montreal, Quebec, Toronto, and Niagara Falls are 3 hours ahead of California time.
16. **Trip Insurance:** We highly recommend taking out trip insurance when traveling out of the state.
17. **Walking:** The Montreal, Quebec, Toronto, and Niagara Falls tour will involve walking at the airports, to and from meals, and to the many attractions. Please start taking small walks now so you will be prepared for this tour.
18. **Perfume & Cologne:** If you use perfume or cologne, please apply it very sparingly, so only you can smell it. Many of our clients have severe allergic reactions to scents such as perfume or cologne. As a courtesy to the other passengers on board the motor coach, please limit your use of all perfume & cologne.
19. **Covid-19 and Influenza Vaccinations:** We highly recommend that all passengers on this tour be vaccinated with the latest Covid-19 booster shot. We also highly recommend that all passengers on this tour be vaccinated with the latest flu shot. Please Note: This is a recommendation and not a requirement.
20. **Tour vs. Vacation:** It is important to understand that a guided group tour is very different from a leisurely vacation. Setness Tours fills each day with many tour sites and activities, and tries to provide our clients with value for their dollar. There may not be time for leisurely lunches & dinners or time to shop at each store you see. So please be aware that there are major differences between tours and vacations.
21. **Group Travel:** When you travel in a group, it is very important to be on time each day and to be courteous and respectful of your fellow travelers. Group travel is just that, a group traveling together and enjoying the tour sites, hosted meals together, and making new friends. During your downtime, you are free to do what you want, but during group time, you must do what the group does or opt out.

The tour price does not cover costs and expenses, including the return home if you leave the tour at your own volition, due to illness, or due to any event beyond our control. Trip insurance is recommended to cover those types of expenses.
