**Day 1 Wed., Sept. 30th Fly To Minneapolis & Mall of America**

**Day 4 Sat., Oct. 3rd Grand Portage State Park, Gooseberry Falls State Park, Two Harbors Light Station, Great Lakes Candy Kitchen and a Harvest Dinner Cruise (B, L, D)**
